



Short and long term goals

1. To ensure the film is disseminated widely and shown in public places across the city. E.g. Hull FC.
2. For the Anti-Racism in-school policy to be adopted across schools in Hull and within the Hull City Council.
3. To translate the Anti-Racism film into books, podcasts and other languages.
4. To develop teacher training resources for teachers around racism & ensuring these features in the teacher training curriculum at the University of Hull.
5. To develop online refresher courses for private/public sector organisations in Hull and East Yorkshire around racism.

Long term goal

1. A develop a dedicated website, and telephone numbers for people to report any racist incidents in school and outside school. This will help track and assess the prevalence and cases of racism in Hull.
2. To have a safe and non-judgemental space where we can have a conversation, share experiences, provide peer to peer support. Also, receive specialist support from a trained counsellor/Psychologist from the BAME community who understand our struggles.
