Community VISION CIO, in partnership with East Riding of Yorkshire Council, the East Riding Safeguarding Children Partnership and the East Riding Safeguarding Adults Board, offers additional support to all Voluntary, Community, Faith and Social Enterprise (VCFSE) groups and organizations, including the faith sector, working with children, young people and adults, in order to ensure they are able to meet their safeguarding responsibilities and keep people safe.

We offer a range of support to the VCFSE sector in regard to developing safeguarding policies and procedures, as well as providing access to Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks, which are processed on line using our umbrella body U-Check and priced at a competitive rate, as well as providing a variety of policy templates, including those related to safeguarding and links to reputable insurance brokers who specialise in voluntary activity.



What we offer

- Access to our policy templates and related information, including explanatory videos.
- Access to a range of appropriate safeguarding related training.
- Regular information from a variety of safeguarding sources via our monthly E-bulletin.
- Access to information events and conferences covering a range of safeguarding topics, both face to face and online.

We provide support to, and work in partnership with, local voluntary, community, social enterprise and faith sector staff, both paid and unpaid. We offer networking opportunities, signposting to relevant trusted safeguarding services and any other related information and advice.

Training, Community VISION are able to offer bespoke digital and face to face training in children and adult safeguarding, domestic abuse and other related topics. These sessions can be tailored to meet the training needs of your individual VCFSE organisation, groups and staff.

Community VISION also organise and facilitate events, conferences, forums and focus groups for VCFSE and partners, in conjunction with the wider safeguarding partnership.
