We are looking for adults living in Yorkshire who are using social care services for support with food to be part of a public involvement group for a new project. This may include support with:

- Food shopping (online and in-store)
- Food and meal preparation
- Eating or mealtimes

This would include services provided by a local authority, paid for privately, and through community food providers and Lunch Clubs.

Please note this does not include people living in residential care or supported accommodation.

You will be invited to take part in **three 2.5 hour workshops** to help design a programme of future research on the topic of food support in adult social care. As a thank you for your time, you will receive a £82.50 gift voucher after attending each session (£247.50 in total). Refreshments and travel reimbursement will be provided. Please let us know if you have any access requirements.
